Responsible to Camp Director

Qualifications:

- 18 to 99 years old
- One year of leadership experience in organized camping, preferably at Camp Wilderness Ridge
- Skilled in a variety of camp activities.
- Must have a proven ability and desire to lead, learn, and give as a servant of Jesus Christ, to meet the needs of all campers and staff.
- Must have a written testimony of faith and trust in Jesus Christ alone for eternal life.

Responsibilities:

- Attend all staff prayer and devotion meetings, lifting up yourself, the campers and fellow staff in prayer.
- Study and know the curriculum materials, notes and memory verses, so that you can reinforce what is being taught at campfire time.
- Participate in creating the activities and events (overnight campout) schedule for Woodsman and Ranger Challenge camps. Expect participation of six (6) cabins each session with eight (8) campers per cabin.
- Know the emergency procedures for weather and fire dangers.
- Daily management of the execution of that day's schedule.
- Lead before meal time formation at flag poles (except campout) and daily distribution of mail (US Mail & emails).
- Lead or assist an activity when needed.
- Camp Director Requirements:
 - Meet with Camp Director prior to summer sessions to assist in the development of the curriculum and supportive activities.
 - Participate weekly with camp administrator and Camp Director in making camper cabin assignments.
 - Meets daily with Camp Director to review the day and to look ahead to the next day.
- Servant-Leader Requirements:
 - Make sure that the Servant-Leaders are punctual and present for all morning staff devotional and prayer meetings.
 - Review and explain that day's activities and events with Servant-Leaders at the conclusion of morning staff devotional and prayer gathering.
- SALT Director Requirements:
 - Coordinate with SALT Director for activities or event setups, staffing, and clean-up and restoring equipment and supplies.
- Camper Requirements:
 - Meet campers and families upon arrival at camp prepared to answer questions concerning facilities and schedules.

NOTE: These are not the only duties to be performed. Some duties may be reassigned and other duties may be assigned as required.
