

Summer Program Director

Responsible to Camp Director

Qualifications:

- 18 to 99 years old.
- One year of leadership experience in organized camping, preferably at Camp Wilderness Ridge, but not required.
- Skilled in a variety of camp activities.
- Must have a proven ability and desire to lead, learn, and give as a servant of Jesus Christ, to meet the needs of all campers and staff.
- Must have a written testimony of faith and trust in Jesus Christ alone for eternal life.

Responsibilities:

- Attend all staff prayer and devotion meetings, lifting up yourself, your campers and fellow staff in prayer.
- Spend time reviewing the curriculum booklet provided by CWR so that you can teach campers and staff from this material.
- Camp Director Requirements:
 - Meets weekly to work together for opening and closing camp sessions (including staff training).
 - Meets weekly to talk through Servant-Leader cabin assignments and other leader issues.
 - Meets weekly to talk through his performance and any situations where he questions his own conduct in keeping with the goals and policies of CWR.
 - In Camp Director's absence may be asked to serve in that capacity as well as assist with emergency procedures.
- Servant-Leader Requirements:
 - Works with each servant-leader and is responsible for their performance, growth, and development.
 - Encourages servant-leaders in their personal goal setting in the context of Luke 2:52 – *“And Jesus grew in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men.”*
 - Completes staff evaluation form for each servant-leader and gives to Camp Director after camp concludes.
- Camper Requirements:
 - Responsible for the placement of the campers in their cabins.
 - Meets campers and families on changeover days and is prepared to answer questions concerning facilities and schedules.
- Program Requirements:
 - Responsible for scheduling field trips and coordinates necessary transportation after prior approval of Camp Director.
 - Directs overall camp activities each session, using servant-leaders, SALT Director, and campers as the foundation for planning and execution.
 - Responsible for the overseeing of inventory of supplies and equipment needed to complete camp activities, ordering (prior approval of Camp Director) as well as putting away when activity completed.
